# Suppose I want to make some videos

- to show family genealogy goodies
- to talk to my future descendants
- to record things “for posterity”
- to show how to do things on the computer (training videos)
- to simply say Hello to family in video format

# General rules

- I'm not a film maker nor a professional, so whatever application I choose should be as economical as possible, preferably free
- The application should be easy to use
- I use Windows computers, but a universal method would be nice
- I don't want to worry about freeware loaded with virus'

# Zoom !!

- Surprise, Zoom sessions can be recorded
- I already use Zoom
- Zoom can record both input from your camera and voice and shared applications
  - Any application you can run! Including sharing iPad screens from a PC
- You can record a Zoom session where there is only one participant
  - Therefore, I can create a “show” with just my voice and any application

# How To Make Videos in Zoom

- Plan your show, create a script
- Write any documents that you will display, aka Powerpoints
- Do a practice session

# Zoom steps 1 (ppt, application, finis)

- start all the applications you are going to share
- start a Zoom meeting as the host, join with Audio
- from lower bar, select “Share screen”, select Powerpoint, F5 to start show
- minimize active speaker
- from share bar, select “more”, **Record on this computer**
- proceed with PPT **TALKing**
- from share bar, select “New Share”, select next application
  - Talk thru this application
- from share bar, click “Stop Share”
- finish **TALKing**
- from lower bar, **Stop recording**, end the meeting, let it create the video



# Zoom steps 2 (intro, ppt, application, finis)

- start all the applications you are going to share
- start a Zoom meeting as the host, join with Audio
- from lower bar, select “Share screen”, select PowerPoint, F5 to start show
- minimize active speaker
- from share bar, click Stop Share
- from lower bar, **Start Recording** (alt-R)
- proceed with Intro **TALKing**
- from lower bar, select “Share Screen”, select PPT show
- proceed with PPT **TALKing**
- from share bar, select “New Share”, select next application
  - Talk thru this application
- from share bar, click Stop Share
- finish **TALKing**
- from lower bar, **Stop recording**, end the meeting, let it create the video
